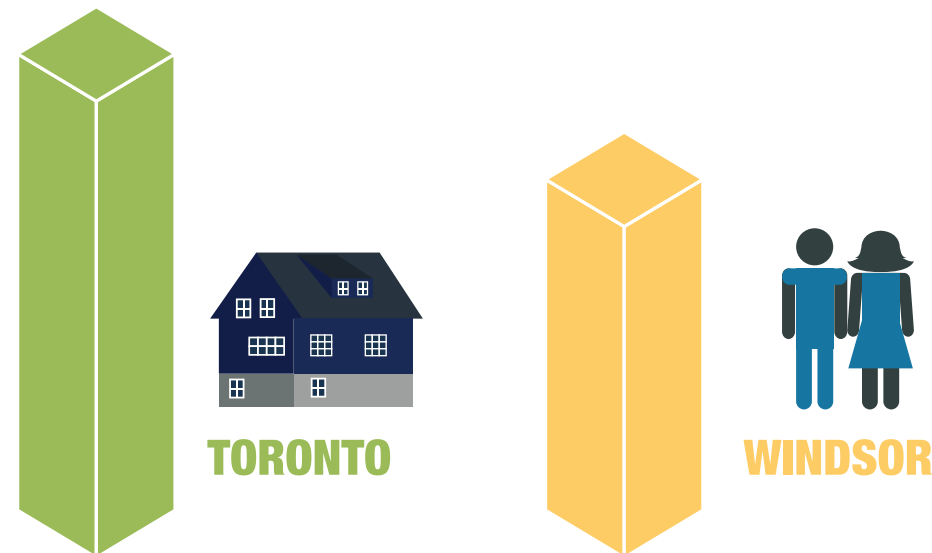
DID YOU KNOW?



have more than 4,000 emergency shelter beds and provided meals, safe accommodation, and a pathway to permanent housing for more than 16,200 men, women, youth and children who used the system in 2014.



Almost three-quarters of the 2014 budget for Toronto's housing and homelessness services went to pay for social housing subsidies and system management.



about 265,000 people live in social housing in Toronto—50,000 more than the population of Windsor, Ont.



delivered housing and homelessness services to vulnerable Torontonians on behalf of the City in 2014.



have used services at the Streets to Homes Assessment and Referral Centre in the downtown core since it opened in late 2010, including street respite, transition to housing beds, referral to shelter, and walk-in housing assistance.
