



CONTEST RULES

Youth Homelessness Prevention Needs Assessment Survey (“Contest”)

from April 4, 2023 ET to 5 pm on May 1st, 2023 ET (“Contest Period”)

Making the Shift Youth Homelessness Social Innovation Lab (“MtS”)

HOW TO ENTER

No purchase required. To enter the Contest, visit the Making the Shift website (the “Website”) during the Contest Period.

Complete the Youth Homelessness Prevention Needs Assessment Survey on the Website during the Contest Period, and include your name and the requested contact information, then click “submit”.

To be valid, entries must be received by 5pm on May 1, 2023 ET.

Limit of one entry per person.

ELIGIBILITY

Contest is open to all Canadian residents who have reached the age of majority in their province or territory of residence at the Contest opening date.

PROCEDURE FOR AWARDING PRIZES

On May 2, 2023, a random draw will be conducted by MtS from among all eligible entries received during the Contest Period. The first selected contestant to correctly answer the mandatory, simple mathematical skill-testing question shall be declared the winner, subject to meeting all the conditions described in these rules.

Winner will be contacted by e-mail during the week following the draw and should claim their prize as instructed by MtS by no later than 7 days after the date they are initially



contacted. If a winner cannot be reached within 7 days following the first attempt of contact, incorrectly answers the mathematical skill-testing question or declines the prize, the prize shall be forfeited and MtS has the right, at its sole discretion, to select another winner.



DESCRIPTION OF PRIZE(S)

The winner will receive their choice of one (1) of the following prizes:

- Virtual Presentation on Youth Homelessness Prevention
- Youth Homelessness Prevention Readiness Assessment
- Hub Solutions 1 Hour Research or Design Consultation

Total approximate value of each prize is up to \$1,000.

GENERAL RULES

To be declared a winner, the selected contestant must first correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question.

By accepting the prize, the winner shall agree that their name and image may be used for advertising purposes related to this Contest free of charge; and releasing MtS, the Canadian Observatory on Homelessness, A Way Home Canada, as well as their respective directors and employees (the "Contest Parties") from all liability for any damage or loss arising from participation in this Contest or from the awarding, acceptance or use of the prize.

The prize shall be accepted as is and may not be exchanged or refunded for an amount of money, sold or transferred. No substitutions will be allowed. Any unused portion of a prize will be forfeited.

If the prize cannot be awarded as described in these rules, MtS reserves the right to substitute a prize or prize component with another of comparable value, as determined in its sole discretion.

Refusal to accept the prize releases the Contest Parties from any obligation toward the winner.

If a contestant makes any false statement, they will be automatically disqualified from the Contest.

All personal information, such as name and contact information, is collected by MtS solely for the purposes of administering this Contest and shall not be used for any other purpose without your express consent. By providing this information, you



consent to it being used for the stated purposes.

If the identity of a contestant is disputed, the authorized account holder of the e-mail address submitted at the time of entry will be deemed to be the contestant. The individual assigned to the e-mail address for the domain associated with the submitted e-mail address is considered the authorized account holder. A selected contestant may be required to provide proof that they are the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with the selected entry. All entries must be submitted from a valid e-mail account that may be identified by reverse domain name search. The sole determinant of time for the purposes of receipt of a valid entry in this Contest will be the Contest server.

Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries. All entries that are incomplete, illegible, damaged, irregular, have been submitted through illicit means, using any robotic, automatic programmed method or do not conform to or satisfy any condition of the rules may be disqualified by MtS. MtS is not responsible for any errors or omissions in advertising this Contest.

MtS reserves the right to amend the Contest rules or to terminate the Contest at any time without any liability to any contestant. Any amendments to these Contest rules will be posted on the Website.
