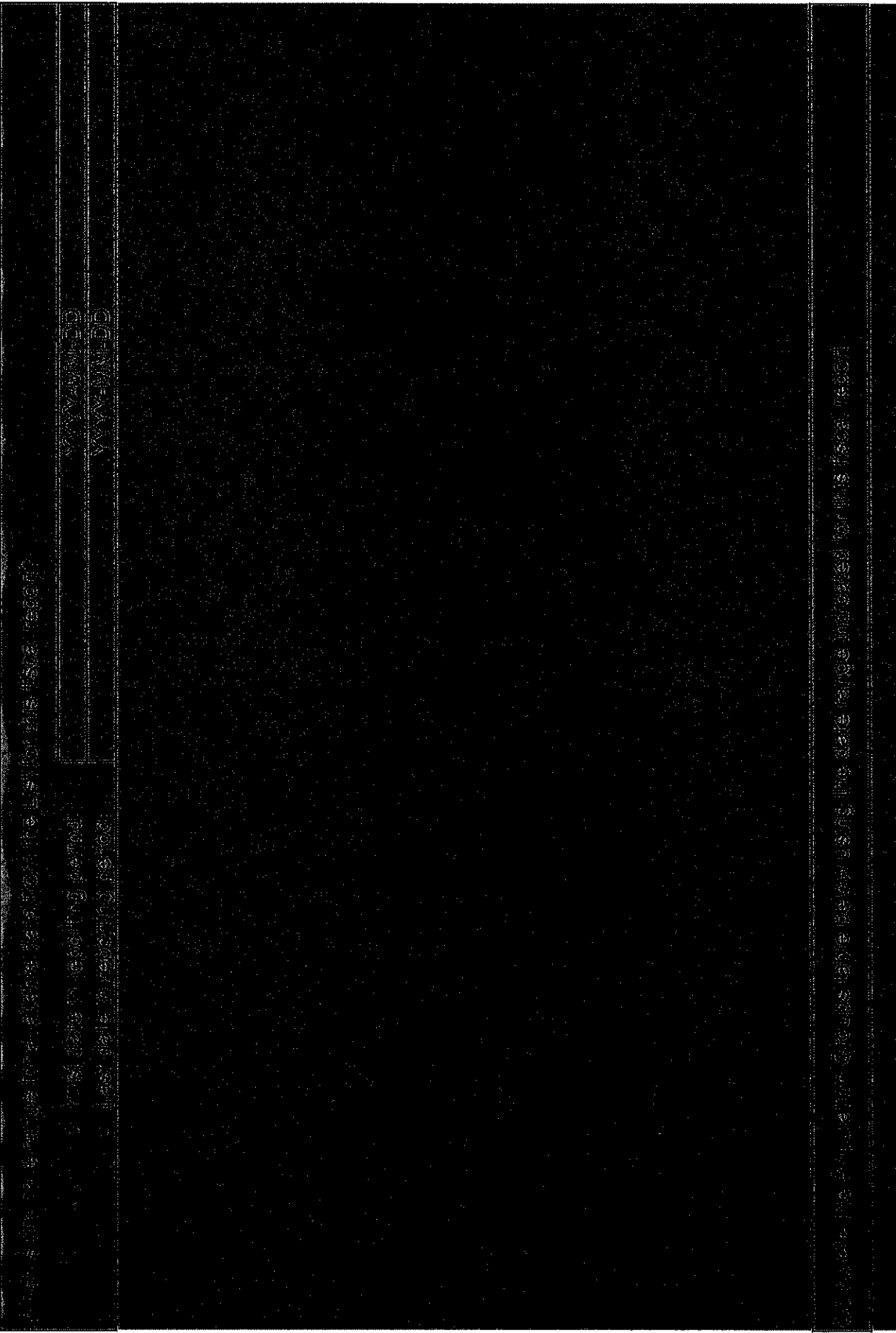

In particular, please describe your community's efforts to set-up or improve the Coordinated Access governance structure, including processes to ensure that policies and protocols, as approved by the governance group(s), are being implemented across the system as intended to achieve desired results.

Living Space (Community Entity) and the community partners in Timmins and across the Cochrane District have successfully collaborated to achieve many key steps required to implement Coordinated Access and end homelessness in our communities. These accomplishments include the development of the district's first Community Advisory Board (CAB) composed of key stakeholders from important sectors; including mental health, housing, Indigenous organizations, municipal leadership, and health care. The CAB in collaboration with Living Space has developed and implemented governance models and the initial policies and procedures for the Coordinated Access System, HIFIS, and for the safe guarding and protection of data collected as part of CAS activities. An important accomplishment includes advocacy for the breaking down of silos across systems to ensure equitable and easy access to all people experiencing or at risk of homelessness. The BNL for the District is active with new access or referral points being developed throughout the district. Outstanding requirements still underway are expected to be completed throughout 2022.

Based on the information provided in the Community Homelessness Report, the community does not have to report community-level data for 2020-2021 and community-level outcomes for the reporting period.
